

AB 1207: REQUIRED MANDATED REPORTER TRAINING DEADLINE MARCH 30, 2018

Under AB 1207, all child day care facilities licensed by the California Department of Social Services (DSS) are required to have employee mandated reporter training completed by March 30, 2018 and then every two years following the date the initial mandated reporter training was completed

Keenan has developed a DSS-approved Mandated Reporter (1207) training course that is available through Keenan SafeSchools/Keenan SafeColleges/Keenan SafePersonnel (KSS/KSC/KSP) called Mandated Reporter: Child Abuse CA 1207. This course can be found by clicking onto the “Mandated Reporter” course on KSS, KSC, or KSP which opens to show three options: (1) Mandated Reporter (CA 1207), (2) Mandated Reporter (33 min for AB 1432) and (3) Mandated Reporter (AB 1432 Spanish version).

There has been some confusion as to what employers and employees are subject to in this mandate, as opposed to AB 1432, which also requires mandated reporter training. The chart below compares the requirements of both laws. Please note, that there is overlap between these laws.

School district and college employees that work at DSS-licensed child day care facilities are subject to both training mandates and will be required to complete both trainings within the time periods set forth in both laws.

When does the training need to happen?	Within 6 weeks of first being employed by the employer subject to AB 1432, and	On or before March 30, 2018, and every two years following the date on which the person completed the initial mandated

	annually , within the first 6 weeks of each school year	reporter training. For employees hired thereafter, within the first 90 days the person is employed at the facility and thereafter every two years following the date on which the person completed the initial training.
